### 4. Delegates

- CPHO- Dr. Ekua Agyemang
  - Presentation and statistics on TB in Nunavut and Arviat
  - Introduction to TB outbreak in Arviat
  - Says there were 2 cases of active TB in Arviat where they had to be flown out on medivac for treatment.
  - Says there is a possibility of a widespread contact
  - Says there will be testing done over a period of one year
  - Says they will be making a public service announcement on the radio
  - Says the main cause of spreading TB is by smoking together with an infected individual
  - Says that mask are not mandatory but optional
  - Says the graphs show TB has been around for a while
  - Says that the hockey tournament is not a concern
  - Says that they will be screening individuals that have had TB in the past and will do a long-haul screening for people in Arviat.
  - Says COPD is different than TB
  - Says for those who are experiencing symptoms, it is a good opportunity to be screened
  - Says sleeping TB can become active.
  - Says the risk of having TB in Arviat remains the same
  - Says they have special focus in Arviat due to the 2 confirmed active cases
  - Says they will start screening for those who are at most risk

- Says there is a team from the Canadian Red Cross who are assisting the health centre

  - Says they will be screening using steps, following a list
